You may have noticed a whole lot of busy bees around Ballan Primary School this year. That's because we have embarked on implementing School-Wide Positive Behaviours (SWPBS) and bees are our symbol – to remind us to 'be respectful', 'be responsible', 'be safe' and 'be a learner'. These are our behaviour expectations and you will see them on the behaviour matrix (below) and posters all around the school and in classrooms.

SWPBS is an evidence-based framework for responding to student behaviour. It aims to create a positive school climate, a culture of student self-regulation and an open, responsive management system for all school community members. SWPBS also supports the development of safe, purposeful and inclusive school and classroom learning environments, while providing individual behaviour and learning supports needed for all students to achieve academic and social success.

Look out for our SWPBS behaviour expectations at assemblies unpacked through Values, Student of the Week awards, playground awards, classroom rewards and when your child tells you about their day.
